




## CREATING YOUR E-PORTFOLIO FOR THE UNT PEACE CORPS PREP CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

You will create an e-portfolio of your experiences in the UNT Peace Corps Prep Program that you can share with your Peace Corps recruiter when you are ready to apply to be a Peace Corps Volunteer. The e-portfolio will also serve as your vehicle for submitting your work to earn your UNT Peace Corps Prep Certificate.

Please set up your e-portfolio immediately so that you can update it as you complete PCP experiences. Pro tip: your e-portfolio will be most meaningful if you are writing about your experiences soon after they occur.

## **Directions for setting up your e-portfolio project:**


- ☐ Log into my.unt.edu
- □ Look for the "e-portfolio" block on your dashboard and click in the top link (first word of the paragraph that says e-portfolio)



- o If you have not yet started your e-portfolio you will be led to sign in again.
- You will be asked to read through the end user license agreement, initial, and agree
- o Then, you will identify your anticipated graduation date.
- Pro tip: Fill out your profile information to present alongside your Peace Corps Prep e-portfolio project!

☐ Click project icon




☐ Click create project



☐ Select "YES" on this page. If asked, select "Peace Corps Prep Certificate" and your template will open.


