Welcome to UNT's Peace Corps Prep Certificate program! The Peace Corps Prep Program (PCPP) is a formal partnership between the University of North Texas and the U.S. Peace Corps to help prepare students for service as Peace Corps Volunteers or for global careers.

Training and Experience in a Work Sector

- ☐ 9 advanced semesters hours in a subject related to a Peace Corps Work Sector
- ☐ 50+ hours over a minimum of 3 months of hands-on volunteer/ service learning/ internship experiences related to a Peace Corps Work Sector (see The Center for Leadership and Service or the Career Center)

Intercultural Competence

- ☐ 3 hours from Core Intercultural Competence List
- ☐ 6 hours from the Core or other Intercultural Competence List

Professional and Leadership Development

- ☐ Meet with the UNT Career Center regarding resume and interview preparation skills
- ☐ Have a documented Leadership Experience
- ☐ Create an e-portfolio of your experiences in the UNT Peace Corps Prep Program that you can share with your Peace Corps recruiter when you are ready to apply to be a Peace Corps Volunteer. The e-portfolio will also serve as your vehicle for submitting your work to earn your UNT Peace Corps Prep Certificate.

- ☐ Work with the UNT Peace Corps Prep Coordinator to receive your Peace Corps Prep Exit Checklist that you will upload with your Peace Corps Application. This is your only official verification that you are a PC Prep student!
